Morning Drop Off Instructions

Things to Remember!

- Stay in your vehicle to be temperature checked
- Have your health questionnaires ready students are not admitted to school without it!

Early Education (Preschool and PreKindergarten)

- Park in the lower church lot off Engrem Avenue (one way street to Route 7)
- Walk your child to the front door of the school (on Route 7)
- Have your child get a temp check and hand in your health questionnaire
- Have a great day!

If you have children in other grades, please use the line for the next youngest child first and then drop off your preschooler. Only parents of preschool and prekindergarten are allowed to park and walk their children to school.

Kindergarten & First Grade - students are to remain in cars until they are checked.

- Drive into to K/1 carline next to the elementary school building off Route 7
- Parent volunteers will help direct you into one of two lines (for faster checking!)
- Keep your child(ren) in the car until they are checked and have handed in the health questionnaire
- Students then enter the building through the main entrance and go to their classrooms.
- Have a great day!

Second Grade through Eighth Grade - students are to remain in cars until they are checked.

- Drive into the 2-8 carline into the parking lot off Killington Avenue
- Parent volunteers will help direct you into one of two lines (follow the blue arrows!)
- Keep your child(ren) in the car until they are checked and have handed in the health questionnaire
- Students in 2-5 then enter the building through the main entrance and go to down to Moroney Hall until 8:00 am
- Students in middle school then enter the gym until 8:00 am.
- Have a great day!

PLEASE NOTE!

- If you who arrive after 7:55 am you must go through the Killington Ave carline no matter what grade your child is in.
- If you arrive after 8:15 am, you will need to park and call the school office at 773-0500. Someone will come out to your car to do a temperature check.
- Students MUST have their health questionnaires to be admitted into the buildings. Each child needs to have one. Health questionnaires will help us to facilitate a smooth start to the day.
